

**2025 THEME: "FRIENDSHIP: THE HEARTBEAT OF GLOBAL PEACE"**




"Friendship: The Heartbeat of Global Peace", this year's theme, highlights the power of friendship to foster understanding, collaboration, and peace across borders.

First through Fifth Place Winners receive cash awards and will be advanced to the Sister Cities International Competition. The Award Ceremony is April 19, 1-3 at Scottsdale Civic Center Library. Extended deadline to enter: March 20.

We encourage youth to be creative & examine all aspects of the theme, including but not limited to: transcending cultural & language barriers to create lasting peace, symbols, imagery, how friendships inspire positive change, acts of kindness. What does the "heartbeat" of global peace look like in your personal experience of friendship?

Entrants must be aged 12-18 on or before April 1, 2025.

### SCOTTSDALE YOUNG ARTIST & AUTHOR SHOWCASE GUIDELINES

<b>Entry Deadline</b>	Forms, Written Entries & Artwork must be delivered on or before <b>March 20, 2025</b>
<b>Requirements for Visual Art</b>	Dimensions of art not to exceed <b>18" X 24"</b> , <b>2-Dimensional art only</b> (3-D art and art reliefs will not be accepted) Submit unframed, one entry per student. Art must be original in creation and content; no copies of other artists’ work will be accepted. (Please pay particular attention to the SCI plagiarism policies.) Judges will evaluate entries based on theme interpretation, technique, creativity & originality. Accepted entries will be on display at the local showcase. 1 <sup>st</sup> thru 5 <sup>th</sup> Place Winners will advance to international competition electronically. A selection of entries may advance to Kingston, Ontario Teen Art Exchange (electronically - digital image, not original art)

<b>Requirements for Literature: Essay or Poetry</b>	Writing may be an <b>essay, maximum of 500 words</b> , or <b>poetry, a maximum of 200 words</b> , not exceed 25 lines, must be double-space typed in English, one entry per student. Judges will evaluate entries based on theme interpretation, composition, and grammar. All work must be original and inspired by the theme. Email Entry Form and digital copy of original essay or poetry to: <a href="mailto:info@scottsdalesistercities.com">info@scottsdalesistercities.com</a> Winning entries will be on display at the local showcase.
<b>Eligibility</b>	Entrants must be ages 12-18 on or before April 1, 2025. Residents and/or students of Scottsdale and the surrounding area are eligible.
<b>Professional Jury</b>	Place Awards and Exhibition pieces will be selected by professional jury. Results will be announced by email to participating art/writing teachers by March 25, 2025.
